



MEETING NOTICE

The Orange County Local Government Affordable Housing Collaborative (The Collaborative) invites you to attend its March meeting. Due to the coronavirus (COVID-19) situation, the meeting will be held virtually on **Thursday, March 26, 2020**, from **5:30 pm – 6:30 pm** via **Zoom**.

The purpose of the meeting is to review applications to the Orange County HOME Program, which awards the County's allocation of federal HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) funds to eligible affordable housing organizations each year.

Key topics for discussion at this meeting are: an overview of the HOME program and the Collaborative, status of past HOME projects, review of Fiscal Year 2020-2021 (FY21) HOME applications, and FY21 project funding recommendations.

Background

In 1992, the four jurisdictions in Orange County formed a Consortium in order to qualify to receive HOME funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). In 2017, the Consortium renamed itself the Orange County Local Government Affordable Housing Collaborative and broadened its charge to encompass larger countywide discussions on affordable housing issues.

The elected bodies of each jurisdiction appointed a member to serve on the Collaborative. The current members are Kathleen Ferguson (Hillsborough), Karen Stegman (Chapel Hill), Mark Dorosin (Orange County), and Susan Romaine (Carrboro). Staff from each jurisdiction are also members of the Collaborative and meet regularly to coordinate efforts and share information.
