

MASTER AGING PLAN TOOLKIT

The Master Aging Plan Toolkit contains many of the materials used by the Orange County Department on Aging to develop its 2012-2017 Master Aging Plan (MAP). These materials are available for use by others wishing to develop their own county aging plans. The Toolkit contains the following information:

- A. MAP Overview - This is a power point presentation describing the entire MAP planning process from start to finish.
- B. MAP Kick-Off Community Forum folder - This folder contains an overview document describing what is in the folder, followed by all of the materials used to support the MAP Kick-Off Community Forum including: publicity, facilitation guides, agendas, and the summary report of the event.
- C. Work Group Process folder - This folder also begins with an overview document followed by folders containing all of the materials used by the five MAP work groups: Housing Options, Transportation and Navigation, Aging in Place, Community Engagement, and Health and Wellness.
- D. Public Comment - This folder contains the survey used to solicit public input on the draft 2012-2017 Master Aging Plan. The survey was made available electronically via the Department on Aging list-serv and web-site and in hard-copy at the Senior Centers and at the seven public forums held in March 2012.
- E. Final Master Aging Plan 2012-2017 – This is the final version of the MAP presented to and accepted by the Orange County Board of County Commissioners on May 1, 2012.
