The voting location for Lion's Club precinct is the first floor recreation/break room of the Carolina Springs Apartment Complex, a living facility for seniors. This location is the only facility appropriate to serve as a polling place in Lion's Club precinct. During our preparation to conduct a presidential election during a global pandemic, the Carolina Springs Apartment Complex proved to be too small and host too vulnerable of a population for us to allow Election Day voting at the facility. As such, we temporarily transferred our Lion's Club voters less than one mile to Carrboro Elementary in Carrboro precinct for the November 3, 2020 Presidential Election. While the school is large enough to host two precincts under one roof, this is not an ideal situation as voters may become confused when presenting to vote.

The Carolina Springs Apartment Complex being the only viable site for a voting location in Lion's Club precinct coupled with the rise in early voting and in addition to COVID-19 now becoming a long-term event, we are recommending that Lion's Club precinct be split among three of the adjoining precincts.


The Orange County Board of Elections is recommending the bulk of the precinct be merged into Carrboro precinct with the voting location remaining at Carrboro Elementary School.

We are recommending the second largest piece of Lion's Club be merged into Owasa precinct. The voting location for Owasa, while adjacent, is currently in Lion's Club. This merge will put the voting location in Owasa precinct and the surrounding neighborhoods will be closer to their voting location.

Finally, we are recommending a small piece of Lion's Club be merged into Town Hall precinct. This merge will put Town Hall's voting location within the precinct boundaries. Voters of Town Hall will then not have to travel past a voting location while in route to their assigned voting location.

### Boundary Description:

Beginning at the intersection of Old Fayetteville Rd and Hillsborough Rd. south following the centerline of Old Fayetteville Rd. to an intersection with Carrboro Town Limits then west following said Carrboro Town Limits as they loop back to Old Fayetteville Rd. Then south with Old Fayetteville Rd, to the intersection of N. C. Hwy 54 crossing said intersection, and including the property of Southern Bell located at the SW corner of said intersection. Thence south once again following the centerline of Old Fayetteville Rd. to its intersection with Jones Ferry Rd. Then easterly following the centerline of Jones Ferry Rd to its intersection with Davie Rd. Then north following the centerline of Davie Rd. to its intersection with W. Main St. then easterly following the centerline of W. Main St. to its intersection with Shelton St., then following the centerline of Shelton St. to its intersection of N. Greensboro St., then north following the centerline of N. Greensboro St. to its intersection with Hillsborough Rd. then following the centerline of Hillsborough Rd. to its intersection with Old Fayetteville Rd.




### Boundary Description:

Beginning at the intersection Jones Ferry Rd. and Berryhill Dr. follow the centerline of Berryhill Dr. south to its crossing of a tributary of Morgan Creek, then south with said tributary to its confluence with Morgan Creek, the following Morgan Creek upstream to its crossing by Smith Level Rd. Then following the centerline of Smith Level Rd. north where after passing under N. C. Hwy 54 it becomes S. Greensboro St. and following the centerline of S. Greensboro St. north to its intersection with W. Main St. Then following the centerline of W. Main St. to its intersection with Jones Ferry Rd. Then following the center line of Jones Ferry Rd. west to its intersection with Bim St. Then following the centerline of Bim St. north to its intersection with Fidelity St. Then following the centerline of Fidelity St. east to its intersection with W. Main St. Then following the centerline of W. Main St. northwesterly to its intersection with Davie Rd. Then following the centerline of Davie Rd. south to its intersection with Jones Ferry Rd. Then following the centerline of Jones Ferry Rd. west to its intersection with Berry Hill Dr.


### Owasa Voting Location:


### Boundary Description:

Beginning at the intersection of N. Greensboro St. and Bolin Forest Dr. follow Bolin Forest Dr. to a point between the homes on Stable Rd. and Bolin Forest Dr. and Bolin Creek Dr. and follow the property lines easterly to the intersection with the N. C. Rail Road right of way. Then follow the N. C. Rail Road right of way southerly to its intersection with the property line that separates the houses on Broad St. and Bynum St. Then south following those property lines to the north end of Starlite Dr. the east along a property line to the property lines separating the house along Starlite Dr. and Sunset Dr. to a point at the NW corner of the property at 100 Starlite Dr. then east with that property line then south with said line crossing Starlite Dr. splitting the property that contains 101 Starlie Dr. and 211 Sunset Dr. and then east with the southern property line of said property to its intersection with Sunset Dr. Then following the centerline of Sunset Dr. south to the northern property line of 604 W. Rosemary St. then east with said line then south following the eastern line of said property to its intersection with W. Rosemary St. Then crossing W. Rosemary St. and following the centerline of Merritt Mill Rd. south to its intersection with a creek north of the homes on Crest Dr. Then following said creek in a westerly direction to the Bike Trail that runs east of Sweet Bay and Red Sunset Place. Following said Bike Trail southerly to the property line between 515 S. Greensboro St. and 750 S. Merritt Mill Rd. then south following that property line to the property line separating 802 S. Merritt Mill Rd. and 800 S. Merritt Mill Rd. then following that property line to S. Merritt Mill Rd. Then following the centerline of S. Merritt Mill Rd. west to its intersection with S. Greensboro St. Then following the centerline of S. Greensboro St. north to its intersection with W. Main St. Then following the centerline of W. Main St. west to its intersection with Jones Ferry Rd. then following the centerline of Jones Ferry Rd. west to its intersection with Bim St. Then following the centerline of Bim St. north to its intersection with Fidelity St. Then following the centerline of Fidelity St. east to its intersection with W. Main St. Then following the centerline of W. Main St. northwesterly to its intersection with Shelton St. Then following the centerline of Shelton St. east to its intersection with N. Greensboro St. Then following the centerline of N. Greensboro St. northwesterly to its intersection with Bolin Forest Dr.


### Town Hall Voting Location:

### **Precinct Change Public Awareness Campaign:**

Voters will be alerted to precinct changes including, but not limited to, the following ways:

Voter Cards – Bright, “biohazard” orange postcards cards will be sent to all affected voters

Newspaper Ads – Ads will be placed in area newspapers alerting voters of the changes

Website – The website of the Board of Elections will have information on the precinct changes with details, satellite images of voting locations, and maps available

Public Awareness Campaign – In conjunction with the community relations department, there will be a public awareness campaign addressing precinct changes. This campaign will use social media, broadcast media, and print media to alert voters of the changes to precincts.
