



# Historic Rogers Road Sewer Expansion



In 2019, OWASA completed construction of new public sewer lines through the historically underserved neighborhood of Rogers Road. This project is part of a larger planning initiative to implement community-driven public infrastructure improvements to the area. Carrboro, Chapel Hill, and Orange County have public funding programs available to assist eligible property owners to switch from private septic systems to the safer and more reliable public sewer system.

## Which Lots Can be Served by the New Public Gravity Sewer Lines?

Using the map on the next page:

 The **green properties** are Heritage Lots without Pre-Existing Dwellings. These properties can be served and the costs of connecting may be covered with Orange County’s zero-interest loan program, subject to completion of a loan application.

 The **yellow properties** are Heritage Lots with Pre-Existing Dwellings. These properties can be served and the costs of connecting may be covered by a 100% public funding program, or Orange County’s zero-interest loan program, subject to confirmation of household income levels or a loan application.

 The **blue properties** are Potentially Serviceable Properties. These properties may or may not qualify for Orange County’s zero-interest loan program or the 100% public funding program, depending on the property’s location, the location of the nearest available public sewer line, and property owner income.

Properties shown with **no color** cannot be served by the public sewer system.
