### EHA PAYS FOR



- current or past due rent
- current or past due utilities
- security deposits
- application fees
- late pet or other landlord fees
- internet (work related)
- housing related court fees

There is a \$6,000/household cap on assistance each calendar year. Repeat applications are welcome.
