Donating and rescuing food on the Careit app is free for every business and nonprofit registered in the US and Canada. Also, it offers in-person and virtual workshops to train new users on safely donating food and using the Careit app. Donation details are available for download in real-time for Municipal Executive Careit account holders. Conduct inspections, track compliance, generate reports, and instantly prove capacity in one account. Counties or groups of municipalities can share data across borders.

Description: Since 1992, Food Donation Connection has assisted food service companies with developing and implementing Harvest Programs designed to provide an alternative to discarding surplus food. Links food service donors with surplus food to local hunger relief agencies by creating and maintaining a communication and reporting network connecting those in need through existing charitable organizations.

Description: For businesses to donate surplus food that would otherwise be thrown out, gain tax deductions, and track it in real-time. The company has drivers/logistics to pick up and deliver food to partners. It also provides organic and typical waste recycling: “We can provide a full overhaul of your current waste solution to add new recycling streams, including procuring bins, education, training programs, and hauling all waste.”

Description: MEANS (Matching Excess and Needs for Stability) is a nationwide online platform connecting those with excess food, like grocery stores, co-ops, and restaurants, with nearby emergency food providers who serve those in need. Food businesses sign up as donors and create a post whenever they have extra food available. When nonprofit users sign up, they tell where they are and what food they need. When any food donation fitting those parameters becomes available on the system, users get an email or SMS text message about it. If interested, they can claim the donation, and they receive the donor's contact information, and the donor receives the contact information of the nonprofit to coordinate delivery. MEANS does not currently allow individuals to post donations.

Description: A licensed food vendor schedules a pickup through the phone app or website by selecting a time frame that works. Food vendors package the food, and then Food Connect’s drivers pick it up and deliver it to a local meal site, food pantry, food bank, or community shelter. Accepts perishable meal donations from licensed food vendors only; individuals can donate canned foods or dry goods using the app.
