It's also home to three tribes of Northwest Coast Native Americans, making it a great place to get a taste of the local culture.

Dedicate your afternoon to sampling the city's natural wonders, enjoy a fishing excursion, or embark on a day spent exploring Cow Bay district, your home base for locally sourced meals.
